Rock selection is also important, taking into account colour, size, durability and shape to ensure the technical and appearance outcomes are achieved.

involved supply and installation of gabion walls, Terramesh walls, reinforced earth, and architectural facades totaling approximately 500 sqm.

Working with the woven mesh cages provides additional durability via the Galmac and PVC-coating. However, the flexible mesh does require a much higher level of care and skill to ensure the face tolerances are achieved.

The completed works drew much praise from not only the client but also the Master Builders Association.
